- 1 Simple Gift in a Will or Trust Provision
 - You can make a gift in your will or add a provision in your trust. You can choose a dollar amount or percentage.
- 2 IRA or Other Qualified Retirement Plan
 - You can name us as a beneficiary of your existing IRA or other qualified retirement plan. You can choose a dollar amount or percentage.
- 3 Life Insurance Policy
 - If you hold an existing life insurance policy or purchase a new life insurance policy, you can name us as the owner and/or one of the beneficiaries.
- 4 Grant from a Donor-Advised Fund (DAF), Supporting Foundation, or Private Foundation Recommend a grant from your donor-advised fund, supporting foundation, or private foundation to the Federation's Endowment Fund. Grants can be made during your lifetime and/or after your death.
- 5 Cash or Marketable Securities
 - You can make a present-day gift of cash or marketable securities to the Federation's Endowment Fund.
- 6 Real Estate or Other Property
 - Donate real estate or other property to us subject to the Federation's real estate or gift acceptance policy.
- 7 Open a Fund with our Community Foundation
 - Establish an endowed fund with the Jewish Community Foundation of Greater Seattle to support the organizations you care about most, including your Federation, for generations to come.
